

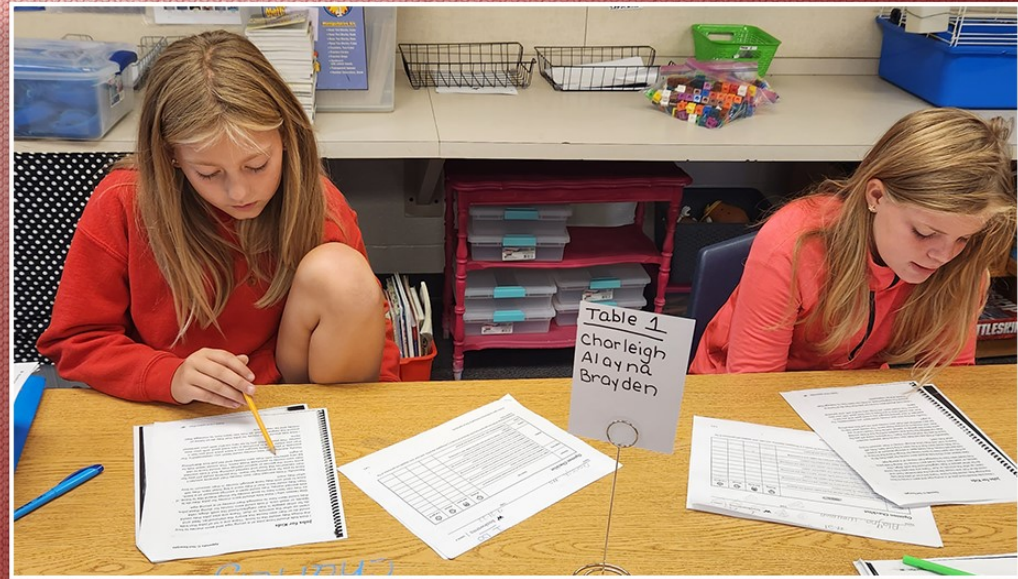

Bookworms - Writing

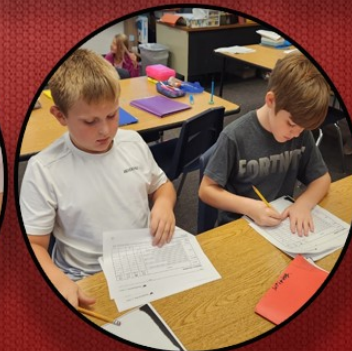
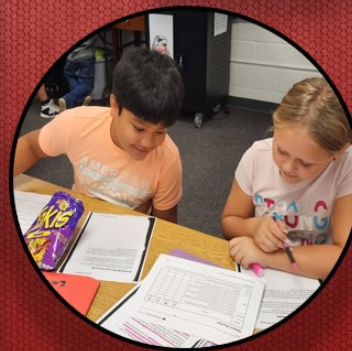
