An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2022-2023. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 20221-2023. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Kent City Community Schools has no schools that are identified as Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI), Additional Targeted Support (ATS), or Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) schools.




